**PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 198**

**AND NOW**, this 20<sup>th</sup> day of May 2013, upon consideration of the applications for reimbursement for services rendered from January through March 2013 by the Auditor of the Avandia Litigation Common Benefit Fund, Alan B. Winikur, as set forth in a letter dated April 23, 2013 and its enclosures, which was submitted to the Court, members of the Plaintiffs' Advisory Committee, and the Administrator of the Avandia Litigation Common Benefit Fund, and finding that the work and fees reflected therein were reasonably necessary for the fulfillment of the Auditor's duties, and without objection from counsel, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the application for fees is **APPROVED** in full.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Administrator of the Avandia Litigation Common Benefit Fund, Andrew A. Chirls, is **AUTHORIZED** to withdraw from the Common Benefit Fund the amount of \$2,725.00 and pay said amount forthwith to Auditor Alan B. Winikur for professional services rendered from January through March 2013.
