AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER (ALL GROUPS)

And now, this 18th day of April, 2012, upon consideration of plaintiffs' motion to extend the Group 1 discovery deadline (Doc. 1024), it is hereby ORDERED that the motion is GRANTED IN PART.

Although the motion is directed to the extension of deadlines for purposes of completing plaintiffs' depositions of defendants' corporate designees, an overall extension is necessary in light of Judge Hey's recent Order granting in part certain defense motions to compel.¹ Because of the impact this will necessarily have on the remaining groups, the deadlines for Groups 2 through 6 will also be extended. However, to avoid extension of the overall deadlines, the Group 7 deadlines will remain the same, leaving Groups 6 and 7 on the same schedule. The new deadlines are set forth in a table attached to this Order, with categories corresponding to the Case Management and Scheduling Orders. All other terms of the Case Management and Scheduling Orders,
