## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 20 (Amending Administrative Order No. 12, Amended Administrative Order No. 12, Administrative Order No. 12A, and Administrative Order No. 13)

THE COURT is examining the necessity of the continued use of the on-line database for submissions pursuant to prior administrative orders of this court and has determined that its use may be suspended pending this examination and until further order of this court.

## THE COURT THEREFORE ORDERS the following:

- 1. Those portions of Administrative Order No. 12, Amended Administrative Order No. 12, Administrative Order No. 12A, and Administrative Order No. 13, which require submissions to the court and to the on-line database MDL875submissions.com are suspended. In lieu thereof, the plaintiffs shall continue to comply with all requirements relating to timely service to all viable defendants.
- 2. The Court may require proof of service and/or submission to the court of the submissions made to the viable defendants if compliance is questioned pursuant to a motion for a rule to show cause. All procedures for motions for rule to show cause outlined in Administrative Order No. 12A shall remain in effect.
- 3. The provisions of Administrative Order No. 14 shall be suspended for actions whose first filing date is subsequent to the date of this order. For the purposes of Administrative Order No. 14 requirements, the first filing date for a severed and amended complaint shall be the date of filing the initial complaint naming the plaintiff or the plaintiff's predessessor-in-interest.
