1. All attorneys appearing before Judge Robreno must

be registered on ECF. All official filings submitted to the Clerk of Court must be filed directly by the attorney on to ECF. All orders, opinions, and other docket entries generated from chambers will likewise be filed directly on to ECF. Notice of these chamber entries will be communicated to counsel either by ECF or ordinary mail.

2. The following materials must be submitted to the Court by **Wednesday, November 11th, 2009:**

- a.) Pretrial memoranda pursuant to Local Rule of Civil Procedure 16.1(c)
- b.) Proposed voir dire questions, jury instructions,<sup>1</sup> special interrogatories, and verdict forms for a jury trial (or proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law for a non-jury trial)
- c.) Exhibits (marked and exchanged by parties)
- d.) Anticipated length of trial
- e.) Stipulations of fact
- f.) Short statement regarding whether the trial should be bifurcated.

<sup>1</sup> Each proposed jury instruction should be numbered, should appear on a separate page, and should include citations to the authorities supporting the proposed instruction.

3. Any pretrial motions shall be filed (with a copy of each also delivered to Chambers)<sup>2</sup> by **Wednesday, November 4th, 2009** and any responses to those motions must be filed by **Wednesday, November 11th, 2009**.
