ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 15

THE COURT HAS previously entered orders establishing an on-line database to maintain and utilize the information contained in the Administrative Order No.12 submissions to the Court. After consultation with the Steering Committees' appointees (The Motley Rice law firm and the Forman Perry law firm), and, having reviewed the proposal of Intercon Inc. to create and administer the Court's database, the Court selected Intercon, Inc. as the Court's administrator for this process. The Court has further determined that the law firm of Forman, Perry, Watkins, Krutz & Tardy (also referred to as "Forman Perry") has the required expertise to input into the database the Administrative Order No.12 submissions made prior to the Court entering Administrative Order No.13, and therefore this law firm has been authorized by the Court to do so at a location off the premises of the United States Courthouse for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania. These prior submissions and all subsequent paper submissions to the Court during the calendar year 2008 shall be handled in the following manner:


1. Prior to the removal from the Courthouse of any of the submissions, they shall be inventoried by the District Court Clerk for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania. Personnel from Forman Perry, or their bonded designee, shall execute a receipt for any and all submissions removed.

2. All manner of papers and documents removed by Forman Perry, or its designee, shall be kept in a secure location at all times and shall not be accessible to any person or entity not authorized by this Court. The value of any losses sustained during this process shall be determined by the Court, the aggregate value of which shall not exceed one hundred thousand (\$100,000.00) dollars.

3. Upon completion of the task of entering the data from the submissions into the Court's database, the submissions shall be returned to the Court where they will be held pending further order of Court.
