

the name Charles Graves and charged with possession of a controlled substance (cocaine), possession with the intent to deliver, and obstruction of the highway. Following a non-jury (stipulated) trial, the defendant was convicted of all charges and was sentenced to 9 months probation on January 5, 1998 (MC 97-10-0607).

4. On May 21, 1998, the defendant was arrested under the name Charles Graves and charged with simple assault, terroristic threats, and violation of a protection order. Following a non-jury trial, defendant was convicted of all charges. On October 9, 1998, he was sentenced to two years probation (MC 98-05-2134).

WHEREFORE, the government respectfully gives notice that the defendant will be subject, upon conviction of violation of Title 18, United States Code § 922(g), to the enhanced penalties set forth in Title 18, United States Code § 924(e).
