INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 24, 1999, at Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

ERROL O'BRIEN, a/k/a "M. Spencer"

knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute a mixture or substance
containing a detectable amount of marijuana, a Schedule I controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 24, 1999, at Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

ERROL O'BRIEN, a/k/a "M. Spencer"

being then an alien illegally or unlawfully in the United States, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate commerce, five semi-automatic weapons and ammunition: (1) one Calico/American Industries semi-automatic rifle, model M100-S, caliber 22 long rifle, serial number D004346, maximum capacity 101 rounds; (2) one Norinco AK-47 style semi-automatic rifle, model MAK-90, caliber 7.62X39MM Russ, serial number 386-9308 471, with laser sight containing 30 live rounds of ammunition; (3) one Smith & Wesson semi-automatic pistol, model 6904, caliber nine millimeter Luger, serial number TDE 5434, containing 15 live rounds of ammunition, plus two extended length magazines, one containing 20 live rounds of ammunition and one containing 9 live rounds of ammunition; (4) one Raven Arms Co. semi-automatic pistol, model MP-25, caliber 25 automatic, serial number 1176140, loaded with five live rounds of ammunition; and (5) one Heckler & Koch semi-automatic pistol, model USP, caliber 40 S & W, serial number 22-31518, loaded with 12 live rounds of ammunition and

having an extra magazine.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(5) .
