I N D I C T M E N T

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 6, 1999, at Philadelphia, in the
Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

CHARLES WILSON

having been previously convicted in a court of the Commonwealth
of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term
exceeding one year, knowingly possessed, in and affecting
commerce, three rounds of .32 caliber ammunition contained in a
Harrington & Richardson .32 caliber revolver bearing serial
number 7362.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section
922(g)(1).
