MEMORANDUM

On June 24, 2005, Omar Ruiz, filed a motion for enlargement of time to file a motion under 28 U.S.C. § 2255. On the same day he filed a motion to vacate/set aside/correct sentence under 28 U.S.C. § 2255.

On June 28, 2005, this Court ordered that the Clerk of Court furnish Defendant with the current forms for filing a petition pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255 and further ordered that the Defendant shall complete these forms and return them to the Clerk of Court within thirty (30) days of the date of the Order or the case would be dismissed.

On July 26, 2005, two days prior to the expiration of the deadline, Defendant filed a motion for stay of proceedings and motion for extension of time. This motion contains absolutely no reason why this Court should grant the relief requested. For that reason this motion will be denied.¹

We enter the following Order.
