



Request is overly broad. The claim that remains in this case is that Defendant Edward Sweeney was deliberately indifferent to the conditions at the Lehigh County Prison so that Reyes was infected with tuberculosis. A request for all grievances concerning mistreatment of inmates far exceeds the discovery that Reyes requires on this claim. Accordingly, the Court shall limit the required production to all grievances, complaints or other documents related to airborne infection at Lehigh County Prison. Due to the impending trial date in this matter, these documents must be produced to Reyes on or before September 7, 1999, at 1:00 p.m.

It is ORDERED that the Motion to Compel is GRANTED IN PART. Defendants shall produce to Plaintiff, Efrain Reyes, all grievances, complaints or other documents related to airborne infection at Lehigh County Prison, on or before September 7, 1999, at 1:00 p.m.
