SUPPLEMENTAL ADMINISTRATIVE STANDING ORDER

AND NOW, this 12th day of March, 2016, it is hereby ORDERED that Paragraph (3) of the Administrative Standing Order entered in this matter on December 23, 2015 is modified as follows:

(3) for those persons deemed eligible for *Johnson* relief who the Federal Defender did not previously represent, the Federal Defender shall consult with them to determine whether they wish to pursue *Johnson* relief and whether they consent to the representation of the Federal Defender in doing so; and, if so, the Federal Defender shall request appointment and submit requisite financial affidavits for those persons who were not previously appointed counsel under the Criminal Justice Act.
