**CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 13**


**AND NOW**, this 25th day of February, 2009, the Court having designated the Special Master for service related to various matters that may arise from time to time in this litigation concerning electronically stored information, directs the Special Master to review the following filings and provide to the Court the Special Master's recommendation, as set forth below:

- I. Docketed filings to review:
  - Case Management Order No. 1 (Docket No. 3), Case Management Order No. 6 (Docket No. 27), and Case Management Order No. 10 (Docket No. 50);
  - Consolidated Amended Class Action Complaint (Docket No. 41); and
  - Joint Submission on Preservation Order (Docket No. 51-1) and attached Joint Proposed Order for Preservation of Documents and Electronically Stored Information (Docket No. 51-2).
  
- II. Recommendation to be Provided to the Court:

With respect to the Joint Proposed Order for Preservation of Documents and

Electronically Stored Information (Docket No. 51-2), the Special Master shall make her recommendation to the Court for resolution of the dispute between and among the parties concerning the proposed provisions at Paragraphs III H 2, 3 and 4, with particular attention to reconciling to the extent feasible (a) existing caselaw; (b) the goals of minimizing (1) delay of the Litigation, (2) expense to the parties, and (3) future disputes with respect to discovery relating to such issues; and (c) maximizing the goal of the efficient administration of justice. The Special Master may contact any Liaison Counsel (with contemporaneous notice to all Liaison Counsel and to the Court of such contact) to request any necessary supplemental information deemed useful to the formulation of her recommendation. The Special Master's written recommendation shall be provided the Court on or before March 9, 2009, with contemporaneous copies to all Liaison Counsel. The parties may submit to the Court any written objection to the Special Master's recommendation on or before March 13, 2009.
