**PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 9
(CHANGES TO THE PLAINTIFFS' STEERING COMMITTEE)**

AND NOW, this 20th day of March 2017, after conferences with Co-Lead and Liaison Counsel, and with counsel for the Indirect-Reseller Plaintiffs, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Pretrial Order No. 6, appointing the members of the Plaintiffs' Steering Committee ("PSC"), is **AMENDED** as follows:

1. As the complaint filed by Michael J. Boni, Esquire and the law firm of Boni & Zack LLC, has been voluntarily dismissed, and these counsel no longer represent Indirect-Reseller Plaintiffs in this MDL, they will no longer serve on the PSC.
