**ORDER REGARDING PRO HAC VICE
ADMISSION AND ECF REGISTRATION**

And now, this 29th day of September, 2011, it is hereby **ORDERED** that each attorney who has filed or wishes to file an entry of appearance in these matters **shall** (if they have not already done so) follow **all** of the following procedures with respect to pro hac vice admission. Please note that many counsel who have mailed admission or appearance forms have not completed all of these steps and thus are not currently admitted or receiving email notification of items filed on the MARDOC docket.

Each attorney wishing to be admitted to practice in this court pro hac vice with respect to any case or matter that is part of MDL 875 (MARDOC)¹ shall be admitted pro hac vice and no formal motion is required.² To be admitted pro hac vice an attorney must:

- (1) submit a one-time payment of the appropriate attorney admission fee and
- (2) register once on the Eastern District of Pennsylvania's Electronic Case Filing (ECF) system.

For the attorney admission fee, each attorney must submit a check in the amount of forty (40) dollars, payable to Clerk, U.S. District Court, mailed to:

¹If counsel has already completed their pro hac admission and registered on ECF on another MDL 875 matter, counsel need not do so again with respect to MDL 875 (MARDOC).

²See Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation Rule 1.4 ("Any attorney of record in any action transferred under Section 1407 may continue to represent his or her client in any district court of the United States to which such action is transferred.").

To register on ECF, each attorney must submit an ECF Registration form, available at <https://ecf.paed.uscourts.gov/html2/us16000.html>, and attached hereto as Exhibit "A." **An email address must be provided on this form for the attorney to be registered on ECF.** The form can be mailed to the Clerk of the Court with the attorney admission fee, and should indicate that the attorney wishes to be admitted pro hac vice for purposes of MDL 875 (MARDOC). A list of cases is not required.

The pro hac vice admission fee and ECF registration form must be sent **no later than October 8, 2011.**

By registering on ECF as part of their pro hac vice admission, counsel agrees to review and become familiar with the Pennsylvania Rules of Professional Conduct and the rules of this Court, agrees to be bound by them, and consent to discipline thereunder.

The Clerk's Office is directed to file this Order on the MDL 875 MARDOC docket and serve it on all counsel of record in the MARDOC cases, including by mail to all counsel not yet registered on ECF.
