
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 22

CONSENT TO TRIAL IN THE EASTERN DISTRICT OF PENNSYLVANIA

**AND NOW**, this **6th** day of **December**, **2010**, it is hereby **ORDERED** that, in cases in which the Court issues a Suggestion of Remand, parties have **seven (7) days** within which to consent to a trial before an Article III or Magistrate Judge in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania. Parties shall file a stipulation of consent on the docket.

If consent is granted, a trial will be scheduled within **sixty (60) days**, at a date convenient to the parties in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and the Suggestion of Remand will be vacated.
