I N D I C T M E N T

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about January 5, 1998, at Philadelphia, in the  
Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**SAMUEL SCOTT**

having been previously convicted in a court of the Commonwealth  
of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term  
exceeding one year, knowingly received a Davis Model P-380 .380  
caliber semiautomatic handgun bearing serial number AP475849  
which had been shipped and transported in interstate or foreign  
commerce.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section  
922(g)(1).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about January 25, 1998, at Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**SAMUEL SCOTT**

having been previously convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly received an E.A.A. .45 caliber semiautomatic handgun bearing serial number AE80206 which had been shipped and transported in interstate or foreign commerce.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about January 26, 1998, at Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**SAMUEL SCOTT**

having been previously convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly received a Davis Model P-380 .380 caliber semiautomatic pistol bearing serial number AP475818 which had been shipped and transported in interstate or foreign commerce.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

COUNT FOUR

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about March 6, 1998, at Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**SAMUEL SCOTT**

having been previously convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly received the following firearms:

1. A Lorcin Model L-9 9MM semiautomatic handgun bearing serial number L090829; and
2. A Lorcin Model L-25 .25 caliber handgun bearing serial number 343046

which had been shipped and transported in interstate or foreign commerce.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

COUNT FIVE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 17, 1998, at Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**SAMUEL SCOTT**

having been previously convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed, in and affecting commerce, firearms and ammunition, that is:

1. A Glock Model 23C .40 caliber semiautomatic pistol with laser sight, bearing serial number CFK694US, loaded with 10 rounds of ammunition;
2. A Glock Model 29 10MM semiautomatic pistol, bearing serial number CDK386US, loaded with eight rounds of ammunition; and
3. A magazine loaded with live rounds of ammunition.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).
