NOTICE TO PLAN SPONSORS
OF HEARING ON PROPOSED METHODOLOGY
FOR DISTRIBUTION OF TRUST ASSETS¹

On December 12, 2016, the court will conduct a hearing at which Marcum LLP, the court-appointed forensic accountant, will present an explanation of the proposed distribution model about which the Koresko Plan Sponsors received information from the court in October. After Marcum's presentation, the court will permit questions from the plan sponsors. Those questions will be limited to the methodology of distribution and Marcum's determination of whether a plan is open or closed or part of the Trusts. You may submit questions for Marcum's consideration prior to the hearing by emailing lawclerk_jhey@paed.uscourts.gov, identifying your name, contact information, and the Plan in which you have an interest.²

The hearing will take place at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom 17A of the Byrne Federal Courthouse at 601 Market Street in Philadelphia. Arrive early to pass the security screening. Government-issued photographic identification is required to gain access to the building. In addition you will be required to sign in at the courtroom, giving your contact information and which plan you represent.

If you are unable to attend the hearing in person, you may request Judge Hey's permission to participate by telephone. Email any extenuating circumstances precluding your attendance at the hearing in person to lawclerk_jhey@paed.uscourts.gov. You must include the telephone number of the phone you will be using the access the hearing. If Judge Hey grants you permission to participate by telephone, the court will contact you with information regarding a call-in number. Only phone numbers granted access will be able to join the hearing. For those plan sponsors granted permission to participate by phone, if you have any questions during the

hearing, you may email them to lawclerk_jhey@paed.uscourts.gov and they will be addressed during the question-and-answer session.

Any plan sponsor wishing to make an objection to whether their plan is part of the Trusts, whether their plan is open or closed, or to the proposed distribution model must appear at this hearing either in person or by telephone with permission of the court. Written objections must be submitted to the following address:
