ORDER

AND NOW, this 10th day of April, 2015, upon consideration of the Department of Labor's memorandum regarding next steps in this matter (Docket No. 1144), and the Court's April 2 Order regarding the engagement of a forensic accountant (Docket No. 1159), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following three entities will be retained:

- 1) A forensic accountant, who will be responsible for conducting an equitable accounting of the Trusts' assets and the Plans' respective interests in the Trusts.
- 2) A Trustee, who will also serve as the Plans' investment advisor and independent fiduciary.
- 3) An administrator, who will be responsible for processing claims for benefits, paying premiums on insurance policies, and paying interim benefit payments and Plan distributions, as directed by the Court. The Court expects that the Wagner Law Group will fulfill this role, although the details of payment and breadth of function, to include who the administrator will report to, will still need to be determined.

Given this, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Department of Labor shall submit a request for proposal for a Trustee, who meets the parameters set out above. The Court asks that the Department of Labor, in consultation with the Wagner Law Group, provide the Court with three options for a Trustee no later than May 11, 2015.
