ORDER

AND NOW, this 5th day of August, 2020, upon consideration of the Department of Labor’s motion to proceed with the final distribution of the assets of the Regional Employers Assurance Leagues Voluntary Employees’ Beneficiary Association (“REAL VEBA”) and Single Employer Welfare Benefit Plan (“SEWBP”) Trusts (collectively the “Trusts”) (ECF No. 1898), and consistent with the Unified Model of Equitable Distribution adopted by this court (Doc. 1471), **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that any person or entity (including any attorney) who/that has any claim to the monies held in the Trusts who/that has not previously had an opportunity to have such claim addressed by the court, shall submit such claim in the form of a motion filed on this docket with an explanation of entitlement within fourteen days of the entry of this Order. There will no further opportunity for claims on the assets of the Trusts. In that the Court has already determined each plan’s proportionate share in the assets of the Trusts available for distribution, and the plans and plan sponsors have previously had an opportunity to have any claim they may have addressed by the Court, this Order has no application to the plans or plan sponsors.

The Department of Labor shall have fourteen days to respond to such claims, and the claims are referred to the Honorable Elizabeth T. Hey to prepare a Report and Recommendation for disposition.

The court also invites all parties with any interest in the assets of the Trusts, including plans and plan sponsors, to suggest a cy pres recipient(s) to which any nominal assets of the Trusts remaining after the final distribution will be distributed in the sole discretion of the court.
