MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

McLaughlin, J.

September 3, 2002

This Court has received numerous letters and documents from the pro se plaintiff. There has been some confusion as to what procedures need to be followed for filing these letters and documents with the Court. Given this confusion, the Court will set forth the procedures to be followed in the future.

Four separate cases have arisen between plaintiff and defendants: Kelley v. Staff at Camp Hill, Misc. Action No. 02-140; Kelley v. Law, et al, Civil Action No. 02-1457; Kelley v. Hatcher, et al, Civil Action No. 02-1755; Kelley v. Beard, et al, Civil Action No. 02-6699. The Office of the Clerk of the Court

did not realize that these filings were part of the same cause of action because the plaintiff failed to use the proper case number on his filings. All of these cases have been closed except for Civil Action No. 02-1457.

To avoid confusion in the future, all parties are instructed to comply with the following procedures. First, on all further correspondence with this Court, all parties are instructed to identify this case as Civil Action No. 02-1457. Second, the caption in Civil Action No. 02-1457 is amended to include Teresa M. Law, Leslie Hatcher, Julie Knauer, Donald T. Vaughn, Steven Mittian, Kathleen Zwierzyna, A.J. Kowalski, Mr. Field, Mr. Crawford, Mr. Jackson, Jeffrey A. Beard, H. Clifford O'Hara, and Catherine McVey as defendants.

With respect to Defendant's Motion for Clarification, it is the Court's understanding that plaintiff believes he has already filed an amended complaint. As the Court interprets the filings, plaintiff intends the following documents to be his complaint: Document No. 1 from Kelley v. Law, et al, Civil Action No. 02-1457; Document No. 1 from Kelley v. Hatcher, et al, Civil Action No. 02-1755; and Document No. 1 from Kelley v. Beard, et al, Civil Action No. 02-6699. These documents are attached. Additionally, the other filings in the Clerk of the Court's official file for this case are attached. These include plaintiff's Motion for Discovery from Defendants, Answer to

Defendants' Answer and Defenses, and Motion for Partial Summary Judgment. Plaintiff is instructed to send a copy of all further court filings to defense counsel Sue Ann Unger; Office of Attorney General; 21 S. 12th St.; 3rd Floor; Philadelphia, PA 19107-3603.

Defendants have thirty days to respond to the plaintiff's complaint. The defendants do not need to respond to plaintiff's motion for partial summary judgment until further notice from this Court.

An appropriate order follows.

3. All parties are directed to use Civil Action No. 02-1457 on any future documents filed with the court as well as the full caption of the case.



5. Plaintiff's complaint consists of Document No. 1 from Civil Action No. 02-1457, Document No. 1 from Kelley v. Hatcher, et al, Civil Action No. 02-1755, and Document No. 1 from Kelley v. Beard, et al, Civil Action No. 02-6699.

6. Defendants have thirty days to respond to plaintiff's complaint.

7. Defendants do not have to respond to plaintiff's motion for partial summary judgment until further notice of this Court.
