

income, receives \$824.00 a month in disability payments. Therefore, after reviewing Plaintiff's application, this Court finds that Plaintiff qualifies as indigent, and it is **ORDERED** that his Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis is **GRANTED**.

However, Plaintiff's Complaint must be dismissed under § 1915(e)(2)(B)(ii) for failure to state a claim upon which relief may be granted as Plaintiff failed to comply with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 8. Rule 8 mandates that a Complaint shall contain: "(1) a short and plain statement of the grounds upon which the court's jurisdiction depends . . . (2) a short and plain statement of the claim showing that the pleader is entitled to relief, and (3) a demand for judgment for the relief the pleader seeks." Fed. R. Civ. P. 8(a). Plaintiff's Complaint fails to set forth the grounds upon which this Court's jurisdiction depends. See Id.

Plaintiff's hand-written Complaint appears to arise out of a dispute over a check in the amount of \$ 629.00 that he claims was fraudulent. Aside from this one incident involving a fraudulent check, Plaintiff's Complaint is otherwise vague as to any facts that support federal question jurisdiction. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that Plaintiff's Complaint is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
