MEMORANDUM/ORDER

July 14, 2008

The court held a hearing this morning to address the government's "Motion to Preclude Defendant From Using 'Hybrid' Representation." Docket No. 39. At the hearing, defendant Lawrence Edward Brown testified that he is satisfied with the representation of his counsel and does not wish to proceed *pro se*. Defendant's counsel therefore agreed to withdrawal of the motions filed *pro se* by defendant. Docket Nos. 29, 30, 31, 37, 38 and 42.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that:

(1) The government's "Motion to Preclude Defendant From Using Hybrid Representation," Docket No. 39, is GRANTED;

(2) By the agreement of defendant, the motions filed *pro se*, Docket Nos. 29, 30, 31, 37, 38 and 42, are WITHDRAWN without prejudice to resubmission, provided that any resubmitted motion is filed by defendant's counsel of record.
