1. All discovery (including responses) is to be completed by .
2. All dispositive motions shall be filed on or before with **courtesy copies hand delivered to chambers** on the day of filing.
3. All Motions in Limine shall be filed by with **courtesy copies hand delivered to chambers** on the day of filing. Responses to Motions in Limine shall be filed by .
4. A Pretrial Stipulation, signed by all counsel, shall be filed by **(two weeks prior to trial)**. (See Standing Order Re Pretrial Stipulation, attached hereto).
5. JURY SELECTION will take place at **2:00 p.m. on Monday**, .
6. TRIAL DATE: **Tuesday**, . **Note: This case will be a back-up to a previously scheduled trial on this date.** If the Court has not disposed of the previously scheduled case on or before **two weeks prior to trial date**, counsel will be notified of that fact, and this case will then be tried on **drop dead date**.

By **two weeks prior to trial**, plaintiff will report in writing on counsels' serious settlement efforts. Any party may request a conference. A final conference in the above case will be held in chambers, Room 3041, U.S. Courthouse, 1:30 p.m., on the day of jury selection.
