1. DESCRIPTION OF WORK TO BE PERFORMED:

Provide a written quotation for the following statement of work to be performed in courtroom 12A of the Philadelphia Federal Courthouse. The scope of work will entail the installation of Category 6 data cabling, 22/2 AWG shielded mic cable, 16/2 AWG 1P speaker cable rack mounting and the removal of existing cable.

1.1 INTRODUCTION:

The District Court will be removing and installing new category six cables, speaker/mic cable and rack mounting for a new courtroom electronic sound system.

1.2 PURPOSE:

The scope of work will entail the installation of data cabling, speaker, microphone cable from various courtroom locations to the upper bench rack location. These cables are to be terminated according to all applicable telecommunication standards. The scope of work will also entail the removal of existing old category 6 lines and speaker and microphone cables. The courts will also provide Racks to be installed in the Upper bench closets.

1.3 SCOPE

Task 1: The Contractor shall remove all existing lines going in the upper bench rack closet from the various courtroom locations located on diagram raised floor, conduit and ceiling. (see attachment).

Task 2: Contractor shall provide and install two (2) Data Center Cable Runway Vericom 5-foot X 12-inch cable ladder in the upper bench rack closet location. The courts will provide Rack, Vertical Wall Mount Rack, Hang Shop Light and Power Strip outlet. The Contractor shall install the court provided Rack, Vertical Wall Mount Rack, Hang Shop Light and Power Strip outlet in the Upper Bench closet. (see picture)

Task 3: The Contractor shall provide and install 12 strand fiber Berk-Tek interlocking armored distribution – 9/125um Singlemode OS2 – yellow plenum rated fiber with LC to wall mounted box from the upper bench rack location to the 12C IDF closet. (See Attachment) Contractor shall terminate fiber on each end test and label and provide test results to clerk. The courts will provide FOTB-LGX-WP panel and Fiber Optic Patch Panel. Contractor is responsible for exact footage measurements during the court issued walkthrough.

Task 4: The Contractor shall provide and install Ninety-Four (94) Black 4pr plenum UTP cables (level/cat 6 rated for a minimum of 350 megabit). All Ninety-Four (94) Black cables will run from upper bench rack location to various areas around the courtroom (See Attachment). The Contractor is responsible for exact footage measurements during the court issued walkthrough. In the upper bench rack location, the contractor shall terminate all Ninety-Four (94) Black cables test and label on a new Cat 6 patch panel. Contractor shall provide one (1) 48 and (2) two 24 port Cat6 patch panel and assorted color jacks (Yellow, Green, Blue, Black, Red, White) See diagram for specific colored jack locations. The contractor shall terminate the other end with a RJ45 connector for the Prosecution, defense 1 and 2 tables designated floor boxes. The Contractor shall use existing cable to be removed a pull string assistance or reference to the upper bench rack location if needed. All line paths from the various locations are combination or singled to conduit, drop ceiling and raised floor boxes.

Task 5: The Contractor Shall provide and install One (1) Black 4pr plenum UTP cables (level/cat 6 rated for a minimum of 350 megabits) and One (1) Black 16/2 AWG IP speaker cable from the Upper bench Rack locations through conduit to the holding cell area 1 port plate RJ45 yellow jack for cat 6 and 16/2 back of speaker. (See Attachment) Contractor is responsible for exact footage measurements during the court issued walkthrough Contractor shall terminate, test and label each line.

Task 6: The Contractor shall provide and install four (4) 22/2 Black AWG shielded mic plenum cable from the 12A floor boxes in loom tubing under through the raised floor to the upper bench rack. Contractor is responsible for exact footage measurements during the court issued walkthrough. (See Attachment) Contractor shall terminate, test and label each cable.

Task 7: The Contractor shall provide and install Five (5) Black 16/2 AWG IP shielded speaker plenum cable from the 12A upper bench rack through the raised floor to witness area floor box. Contractor is responsible for exact footage measurements during the court issued walkthrough. (See Attachment) Contractor shall terminate, test and label each cable.

Task 8: The Contractor shall provide and install two (2) 4pr plenum UTP cables (level/cat 6 rated for a minimum of 350 megabit) from the drop ceiling above jury box ceiling location to 12C IDF closet (see attachment). Contractor shall install hang court provided WAPS. Contractor is responsible for exact footage measurements during the court issued walkthrough. The contractor shall terminate end with a blue RJ45 connector in a 2-port biscuit box (HSB2W) with a service loop for courts flexibility and connection to the 12C IDF closet should be terminated, tested and labeled into patch panel.

1.4 SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Contractor shall install all cables in compliance with ANSI/TIA/EIA standards for category six cables. Contractor shall test all cables for compliance with current ANSI/TIA/EIA category 6 standards. Contractor shall purchase and install all requested equipment in Task 2, Task 8

2 DESCRIPTIONS OF DELIVERABLES

Task 4: Printout certifying the compliance of the Ninety-Four (94) installed cables with the current ANSI/TIA/EIA standards for category 6 cable. The printout should also include any warranty information applicable for the work performed.

Task 5: Printout certifying the compliance of the one (1) installed cables with the current ANSI/TIA/EIA standards for category 6 cable. The printout should also include any warranty information applicable for the work performed.

Task 8: Printout certifying the compliance of the two (2) installed cables with the current ANSI/TIA/EIA standards for category 6 cable. The printout should also include any warranty information applicable for the work performed.

4 REVIEW PERIOD FOR DELIVERABLES

Upon receipt of the cable test results for each of the tasks, the Contractor shall have three (3) business days to correct any cable errors to obtain a passing test result for category 6 tests up to and including complete replacement of the cabling. These corrections are to be completed at no additional cost the District Courts Clerk's Office.

5 ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA FOR DELIVERABLES

At the completion of each task the Contractor shall provide a printout certifying the compliance of the installed cable with the current ANSI/TIA/EIA standards for category 6 cable. Each installed cable shall pass a category 6 test.

Upon completion of all seven tasks, a visual inspection of the completed tasks will be conducted by a representative of the District Court Clerk's Office. This inspection will include a review of the following: all terminations within the rooms and IDF closets/rack locations where the work was performed. The inspection will also include a review of all cable labeling, fire stopping in the IDF closets and cable ties used within the ceiling.
