Effective immediately, in opinions or substantive orders issued in cases filed pursuant to Section 205(g) of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, any non-government party will be identified and referenced solely by first name and last initial. This change will apply only to opinions and other documents with sensitive medical information issued by the court in Social Security cases, and will not apply to the PACER docket, which will

continue to display the non-government party's full name. Cases filed on behalf of a minor

will continue to refer to the minor by first and last initial.
