**STANDING ORDER REGARDING USE OF GENERATIVE ARTIFICIAL
INTELLIGENCE (“AI”) IN CASES ASSIGNED TO JUDGE PRATTER**

Judge Pratter requires that counsel (or a party representing himself or herself) disclose any use of generative Artificial Intelligence (“AI”) in the preparation of any complaint, answer, motion, brief, or other paper filed with the Court, including in correspondence with the Court. If counsel (or a party representing himself or herself) has used generative AI, he or she **must**, in a clear and plain factual statement, disclose that generative AI has been used in any way in the preparation of the filing or correspondence ***and*** certify that each and every citation to the law or the record in the filing has been verified as authentic and accurate.
