## PRETRIAL ORDER 110

AND NOW, this 16th day of August, 2010, upon consideration of Plaintiffs' Expedited Motion to Strike GlaxoSmithKline's Motions to Exclude Expert Testimony and Its Overview Memorandum (Doc. No. 754), Defendant's letter response thereto, and after telephone conference this date with PSC counsel Joseph Zonies, Thomas Cartmell and Adam Davis and GSK counsel George Lehner and Sean Fahey, it is hereby ORDERED that Plaintiffs' Motion is DENIED in part and GRANTED in part, as follows:

- 1. Plaintiffs' motion to strike all of Defendant's motions to exclude Plaintiffs' expert witnesses is **DENIED**. Plaintiffs' motion to strike Defendant's Overview Memorandum on *Daubert* Issues Related to General Causation is **DENIED**.
- 2. Plaintiffs' motion to file an Overview Memorandum in conjunction with their Daubert/Frye responses is GRANTED. The memorandum shall not exceed fifty (50) pages. Plaintiffs' deadline by which to file Daubert/Frye responses and to file an Overview Memorandum shall be extended to August 30, 2010. Defendant's reply deadline shall be extended to September 10, 2010.
